

## Yes, art glows in the dark at Patrick Turk's 'Trip Hardererrr' at Dallas' Cris Worley gallery

He has the perfect last name for an artist — Turk, as in Patrick Turk. His shows are edgy and different, as he proves demonstrably in his solo exhibition at <u>Cris Worley Fine Arts</u>, which is showcasing his latest through Aug. 18.

The show is "Trip Hardererrr," which boasts 20 mixed-media sculptures and an additional installation seen under ultraviolet light.

Turk is a master of the collage, ones that traverse botanical, commercial, medical, mythical and religious subjects. As Cris Worley Fine Arts says in its description of the show: "Organic and unsettling, his work utilizes a bewitching visual vernacular chosen to question the nature of collecting and ordering our existence." In his own way, this engaging Houston artist calls to mind Salvador Dali, Hannah Höch and Man Ray.
